#### SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

In today's Gospel Our Lord sees that the great crowd of people who have come to hear Him have nothing to eat. He says to His disciples "I have compassion on the

crowd" and then He multiplies the 7 loaves of bread and a few fish to feed the 4,000. Now I've seen our Catholic

mothers do some pretty amazing things at confirmation in feeding all- us but not quite for 4,000! We see Our Lord's compassion for us who go out of our way to hear and do His word. Let us realize that He feeds us not with ordinary bread but with Himself in the Holy Eucharist. How thankful we should be receiving Jesus: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in Holy Communion!! Let us recall that "Eucharist" actually means "Thanksgiving" in Greek. How could we be jealous of whatever anyone else has when we have HIM?! Let us show ourselves thankful!
