

# SEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST How appropriate the Sacred Scriptures are for us today

during this time after Pentecost 2024. -Has the coming of

the Holy Ghost into our souls brought forth any good fruit? Have we grown in our faith or have we fallen backwards? St Paul admonishes us in the Epistle, Romans 6:19-23, "But now set free from sin and be slaves to God, you have your fruit unto sanctification and as your end life everlasting. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is life everlasting in Christ Jesus our Lord". In the gospel our Lord gives us the warning: "Every tree that does not bear fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you shall know them. Not everyone who says to me "Lord, Lord" shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of my Father in heaven shall enter the kingdom of heaven." Let us ask ourselves today "Am I doing the will of my Father?" "Am I bearing good fruit?" " Can I do More?" Remember just because we are Catholics -yes even traditional Catholicsdoes not mean we are going to heaven! We MUST do the Father's will! We can ask the same thing of our nation. 
