Dedication of St. Michael the Archangel



The Archangel Michael stands at the head of the heavenly army which remained faithful to God in the struggle against Lucifer, the leader of the evil,

fallen angels. The Hebrew name Michael actually means "Quis ut Deus" Latin for "who is like to God?" It was the battle cry hurled by him at the rebel-

lious angels. Because of his victorious struggle he was chosen as Protector of the Hebrew people. In 530 AD Pope Boniface II chose Sept 29th to dedicate a church in Rome in honor of St Michael. Today the Catholic Church venerates him

as our "defender in battle".

In the offertory of the requiem Mass we ask St. Michael to introduce the deceased into heaven. In 1886 Pope Leo XIII instituted what would later be known as the "Leonine Prayers" after Mass. Not much is known for certain about the origin of this prayer, but it is believed by many historians that Pope Leo had a profound vision that sparked its creation. During the celebration of Mass he had a vision of demonic spirits, who were gathering on the Eternal City. A visible change come over his face during the vision and one claims that his face was "pale and fearful." Pope Leo witnessed a conversation between Jesus and Satan. Satan says to Jesus: "I can destroy your Church." Jesus replies: "You can? Then go ahead and do so." Satan: "To do so, I need more time and more power." Jesus: "How much time? How much power?" Satan: "75 to 100 years, and a greater power over those who will give themselves over to my service." Jesus: "You have the time, you will have the power. Do with them what you will." What he saw was not pleasant. It prompted him to quickly compose the Prayer to St. Michael, and to request its use at the end of Low Masses in order to dispel the darkness that still hangs over the world.

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle, be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
