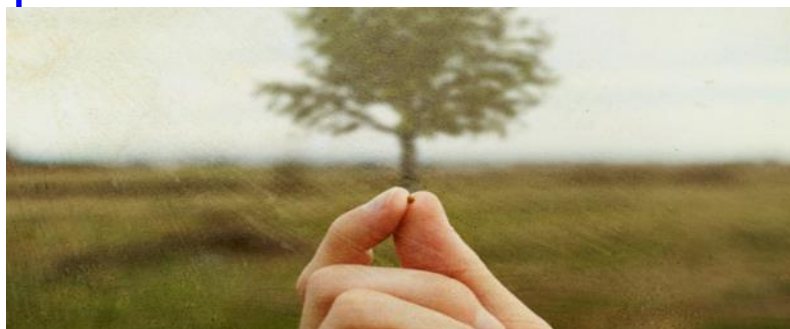

## Sixth Sunday After Epiphany—Resumed



In the Gospel Our Lord uses the parables which compare the growth of the Church to the tiny mustard seed and the yeast that raises up the dough way beyond its original size. The spread of the Church from 12 apostles to 1.2 billion is a proof of its divine origin. It is from God and it is with God. Jesus identifies with His Church.
