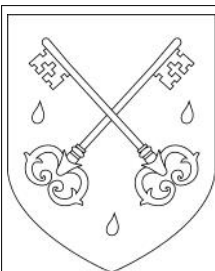

## QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY

Today is the last Sunday before Lent. In the epistle St. Paul exhorts us to practice the greatest of all virtues which is charity. In the Gospel we have the proof of God's charity to us. Jesus tells His apostles that He is going to Jerusalem and that He will be mocked, scourged, spit upon and then they will put Him to death. He sets His Face towards Calvary! "and they understood none of these things that He was saying" "Greater love than this no man has that he lay down his life for his friends". Jesus knows exactly what is going to happen to Him yet He still goes for love of us. What will we do for love of Him this Lent? Like the blind man in the Gospel today let us ask—"O Lord that I may see!" How much we would be willing to sacrifice if we could truly see how much He loves us and suffered for us, how terrible our sins are before our God and how great heaven will be!

**ASH WEDNESDAY-OBLIGATORY DAY OF FAST AND  
ABSTINENCE! – MASSES at 7AM & 7PM.**

Lent officially begins THIS WEDS! Although not a holy day whereby we are obligated to attend Mass, it is however an obligatory day of fast & abstinence. Ashes are blessed and distributed at the beginning of Mass.

Let's start Lent off right!

**ABSTINENCE**– means not eating any meat, soups or gravies that are made from the meat of warm blooded animals. (Ash Wednesday and ALL FRIDAYS of Lent are days of abstinence under pain of sin!)

**LENTEN FAST**—generally means only one full meal per day with meat (unless it is a day of abstinence). Two other meatless meals are allowed but the quantity of these two small meals together should not equal the amount taken at one "regular" meal. Snacking between meals is NOT ALLOWED but liquids may be taken, however, the stricter the penance the greater the grace! The laws of fasting are not binding on those with medical conditions that would cause harm to oneself or to an unborn child within the womb or the elderly over 59 years old.

## SUGGESTIONS FOR LENT

### THINGS TO GIVE UP:

- television—your favorite show or ALL TV!—
- computer—facetime, limit internet & games
- food :dessert, meat, soft drinks, coffee, sugar candy, chocolate or all of the above!
- FAST—ALL 40 DAYS OF LENT . Remember Sundays during Lent are NOT days of Fast! . This is because the Resurrection of Our Lord which occurred on Sunday is always a feast day! Before Vatican II everyone was obliged to fast ALL 40 days! (unless pregnant , in poor health, or elderly) WE NEED THE GRACE!

### THINGS TO DO EXTRA:

- spiritual reading—Sacred Scripture or Catholic Classics like: *The Story of a Soul* by St. Therese of Lisieux, *Introduction to the Devout Life*, St Francis de Sales, *the Imitation of Christ*, by Thomas A Kempis, *Spiritual Exercises* by St. Ignatius of Loyola, *Interior Castles* by St. Theresa of Avilla, *Confessions* by St. Augustine and *Dark Night of the Soul*, St John of the Cross. These are Catholic Classics that every Catholic should read! HAVE YOU READ THEM?
- Daily Mass/Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament or a crucifix
- Increase Prayer/devotions—daily family rosary, Morning Offering, Act of Contrition, Holy Face Novena, scriptural rosary found in Holy Hour booklet, 15 minutes of private meditation placing yourself in the presence of God and listening to Him!
- Corporal Works of Mercy—feed or give drink to someone (such as the SVDP Bag Lunch March 15th), Visit or call an elderly person or someone else who is alone, DRTL baby bottle change or formula or diapers
- Spiritual Works of Mercy—pray for the living and the dead, comfort the afflicted, forgive those who have hurt you in the past, bear wrongs patiently, comfort the afflicted
- Confession—make a good examination of conscience and go at least once a month but do NOT abuse the sacrament!
- It is a good idea to write out your resolutions and place them where you will see them each morning such as on the bathroom mirror to avoid the temptation of changing stones into bread! LENT IS THE TIME TO GET GRACE! GOD WILL NOT BE OUTDONE IN GENEROSITY! REMEMBER NO DEPOSIT- NO RETURN!!
